## **DEDICATION OF THE JOE'S BRANCH WATERLINE**

JENKINS, KY, OCTOBER 9, 2007: A steady rainfall didn't prevent Mayor D. Charles Dixon from joining with city officials and residents of Joe's Branch in dedicating a new waterline. The ceremony was held at 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>.

Loretta Gallion, who worked diligently for many years to see the project brought to fruition, had the honor of turning the valve that allowed water to begin flowing through the line. The 6-inch waterline will provide clean, potable water to twenty six families along Joe's Branch. It is approximately 1.5 miles long extending from the mouth of the hollow to Hwy. 23.

Project Engineer Paul D. Nesbitt, MBA, PE, PLS, and President of Nesbitt Engineering, Inc. added, "The ability to provide potable water today to this many families clearly demonstrates the City's commitment to projects that improve the quality of life for the citizens of Jenkins. I'm really proud that Nesbitt Engineering has been able to play an important role in providing technical guidance for this project".

Prior to the new waterline, most residents relied on wells that could dry up during drought conditions and whose water quality could vary significantly.
